The seminar aims to inform and support teachers regarding the antiracist policy of the Ministry of Education, Sport and Youth, "Code of Conduct against Racism & Guide to Managing and Recording Racist Incidents". Taking into account the particularities of each context, during the seminar, teachers will have the opportunity to reflect on their role in relation to the functions of multiple racism within schools, to discuss the challenges they encounter in managing and recording racist incidents, as well as other aspects of implementing an antiracist policy (e.g. parental involvement, development of an antiracist culture, under-reporting, etc.).
