**GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR
AN ORAL PRESENTATION OR POSTER**

Abstracts for an oral presentation or poster will be included in the Conference Program in the format they will be submitted, and therefore, authors are asked to follow the guidelines below:

1. The text should be submitted in Arial font, size 11pt, as a Word document, single spacing, justified and not exceeding **300 words**.
2. The title of the abstract must be written in **capital letters**.
3. The name(s) of the author(s) must be written in the nominative case, combining capital and lower case characters. The name is referred first, in full, and then, the surname follows, e.g., Michael Papacostas.
4. The name of the presenting author should be written in **bold**, e.g., **Eleni Dimopoulou**.

5. Abstracts should also include author's affiliation, which should be presented under the name(s) of the presenting author(s), using both capital and lower case characters.

e.g., Michael Papacostas¹, **Eleni Demopoulou**² ,

6. Affiliation of the presenting author(s) should not be referred in the title of the paper or in the text of the abstract.
7. Single (1pt) spacing should be used between the following: title, presenting author(s) name(s), affiliation, and the abstract text.
8. The text/paper may contain the standard abbreviations, tables, diagrams, etc. provided that they do not outline the text alignment margins and that the text will not exceed 300 words.
9. Authors must state the thematic entity of their abstract/presentation in the space that is provided in the submission form, as well as the desirable presentation form (oral presentation or poster).
10. Once the work has been submitted, any changes, additions or corrections will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances and only in the case they are sent in a written form exclusively by the corresponding people.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Authors must submit their papers by the posted deadline dates (**10th of September**). **Otherwise the submissions will be automatically withdrawn.**
2. You will receive a confirmation for the submission of the abstract of your presentation or poster, from the corresponding people, within five (5) days. In the case you do not receive the relevant confirmation, please contact the event secretariat at: literacy_cyprus@cyearn.pi.ac.cy.
3. The abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the Conference and the decision will be sent to the corresponding people by the **25th of September 2017**.
4. Authors, whose abstracts will be evaluated, approved and selected, and are interested in publishing their full papers in the Conference Proceedings, must send their final paper until no later than November 20, 2017. Full papers will also be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the Conference and authors will be notified via email until no later than December 20, 2017. Please note that only papers presented at the Conference may be included in the Conference Proceedings.
