GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Abstracts for oral presentations will be included in the Conference Programme in the format in which they will be submitted; therefore authors are asked to follow the guidelines below:

- 1. The text should be submitted in size 11pt Arial font, as a Word document, single-spaced, fully justified and not exceeding **300 words**.
- 2. The title of the abstract must be written in capital letters.
- 3. The name(s) of the author(s) must be written in the nominative case, combining capital and lower case characters. The name is placed first, in full, and the surname follows, e.g., Michael Papacostas.
- 4. The name of the presenting author should be written in **bold**, e.g., **Eleni Dimopoulou.**

- 5. Abstracts should also include the author(s)' affiliation, which should be presented under the name(s) of the presenting author(s), using both capital and lower case characters.
 - e.g., Michael Papacostas¹, Eleni Demopoulou²,
 - ¹ University of Cyprus
 - ² Cyprus Pedagogical Institute
- 6. The affiliation of the presenting author(s) should not be included in the title of the paper or in the text of the abstract.
- 7. Singe (1pt) spacing should be used between the following: title, presenting author(s)' name(s), affiliation, and the abstract text.
- 8. The text/paper may contain the standard abbreviations, tables, diagrams, etc. provided that they do not fall outside the text alignment margins and that the text does not exceed 300 words.
- 9. Authors must state the thematic area of their abstract/presentation in the space provided in the <u>submission form.</u>
- 10. Once the work has been submitted, any changes, additions or corrections will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances and only in case they are submitted exclusively in writing by the corresponding author(s).

Authors must submit their papers by the deadline date (June 21 2019). All other submissions will not be accepted by the automatic submissions system.

You will receive confirmation of the submission of the abstract of your presentation within five (5) days. In case you do not receive the relevant confirmation, please contact the event secretariat at literacy_cyprus@cyearn.pi.ac.cy

The abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the conference and the decisions will be sent to the corresponding authors by **July 20 2019**.

Authors whose abstracts will be evaluated, approved and selected and are interested in publishing their full papers in the Conference Proceedings must submit their final paper no later than **December 10, 2019**. Full papers will also be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the conference and authors will be notified via email no later

than **February 20**, **2020**. Please note that only papers presented in the Conference may be included in the Conference Proceedings.
