GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR

A SYMPOSIUM OR WORKSHOP

Abstracts for a symposium or workshop will be included in the Conference Program in the format in which they will be submitted. Authors are asked to follow the guidelines below:

- The text for the symposium or workshop should be submitted in size 11pt Arial font as a Word document, single-spaced, fully justified and not exceeding 700 words.
- 2. The title of the paper for the symposium or workshop must be written in **capital letters**.
- 3. The name(s) of the presenting author(s) must be written in the nominative case, combining capital and lower case characters. The name is placed first, in full, and the surname follows, e.g., Eleni Demopoulou.
- 4. The name of the coordinator of the symposium or workshop should be written in bold, e.g., **Michael Papacostas.**

- 5. Abstracts should also include the author(s)' affiliations, which should be presented under the name(s) of the coordinator(s) and the presenting author(s) of the symposium or workshop, using both capital and lower case characters.
 - e.g., Michael Papacostas¹, Eleni Demopoulou²,
 - ¹ University of Cyprus
 - ² Cyprus Pedagogical Institute
- 6. The affiliation of the coordinator(s) or the presenting author(s) of the symposium or workshop should not be mentioned in the title of the paper or in the text of the abstract.
- 7. Singe (1pt) spacing should be used between the following: title, coordinator's/ presenting author(s)/names, affiliation, and the abstract text.
- 8. The text/paper may contain the standard abbreviations, tables, diagrams, etc. provided that they do not fall outside the text alignment margins and that the text does not exceed 700 words.
- Authors must state the thematic area of their presentation for the symposium or workshop in the space provided in the <u>submission form</u>, as well as the desired presentation form (symposium or workshop).
- 10. Once the abstract of symposium or workshop has been submitted, any changes, additions or corrections will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances and only if they are submitted <u>exclusively in writing</u> by the corresponding author(s).

Authors must submit their papers by the deadline dates (June 21 2019). All other submissions will not be accepted by the automatic submissions system.

You will receive a confirmation of the submission of the abstract of your symposium or workshop within five (5) days. In case you do not receive the relevant confirmation, please contact the event secretariat at *literacy_cyprus@cyearn.pi.ac.cy*.

Abstracts for symposia or workshops will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the Conference and the decision will be sent to the corresponding authors by the **20**th of July 2019.

Authors whose abstracts will be evaluated, approved and selected, and are interested in publishing their full papers in the Conference Proceedings, must send

their final papers no later than **December 10, 2019**. Full papers will also be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the Conference and authors will be notified via email no later than **February 20, 2020**. Please note that only papers presented at the conference may be included in the Conference Proceedings.
