H2020 OVERVIEW

1.EU's largest legal instrument for <u>funding research</u> and innovation in Europe

2.≈ € 80 billion for the period 2014 - 2020

H2020 Simplification RULES



- •A single set of simpler and more coherent participation rules
- One project one funding rate Maximum of 100% of the total eligible costs (except for innovation actions, where a 70% maximum will apply for profit making entities)







Minimum conditions

✓ Standard collaborative actions

At least **three legal entities** each established in a different Member State or an Associated Country;

✓ ERC, SME instrument, programme co-fund, coordination and support, training and mobility actions: One legal entity established in a Member State or in an Associated Country.

Additional Conditions

In the WP or work plan - always check the WP

- √There might be specific conditions for participation
- ✓ e.g SME involvement is an evaluation criteria

The Commission has an **online register of the beneficiaries** participating in the EU research and innovation, audiovisual and cultural programmes. This allows consistent handling of the beneficiaries' official data and avoids multiple requests for the same information.

If you want to participate in a project proposal, your organisation needs to be registered and have a 9-digit Participant Identification Code (PIC) that is the unique identifier of your organisation and will be used as a reference by the Commission in any interactions.


